- Solicit, receive, hold, and manage goods and funds donated to improve the library; serve as trustees and stewards for donations made to the library








Why Join the Friends of the Pleasanton Library?



How to Donate Your Books, CDs, DVDs, LPs, Games, Puzzles


- Drop off your items:


